The powerful motoryacht perfectly combines the performance typical for a Wajer 38 with the qualities required for the finest leisure sailing.



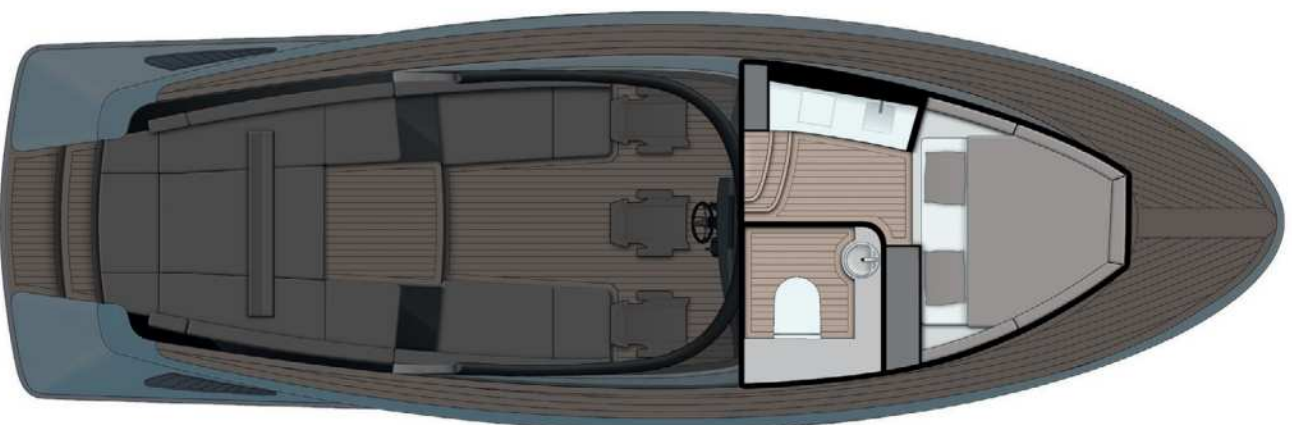

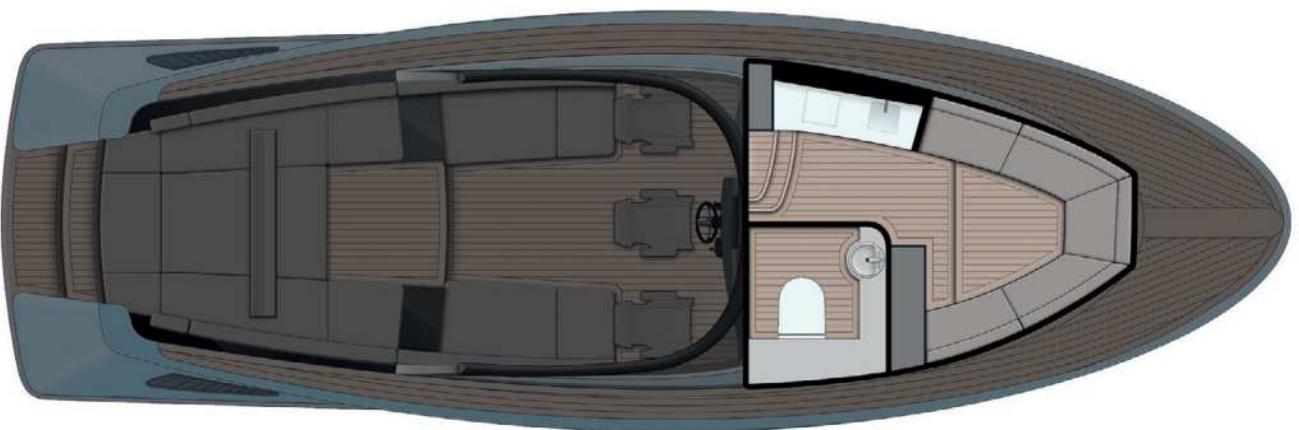
The Wajer 38 can optionally be fitted with two powerful Volvo D6-DP 435 hp six-cylinder diesel engines in combination with IPS600 dual pod propulsion. This extremely efficient joystick-controllable propulsion system provides greater ease of operation and more precise steering compared to conventional propeller shaft propulsion, as well as a 10 to 15% higher performance and a remarkable top speed of 45 knots (approx. 85 km/h). Weight savings of over 300 kg have been achieved via ingenious techniques such as the use of new lightweight materials.

The exceptionally strong hull optimises the dynamic sailing characteristics, while the unprecedented course stability and manoeuvrability at high speeds provide a sense of total control.

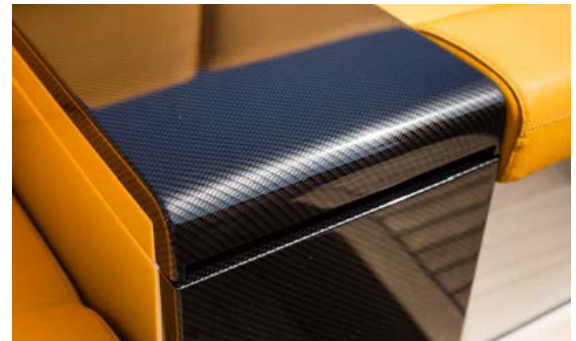

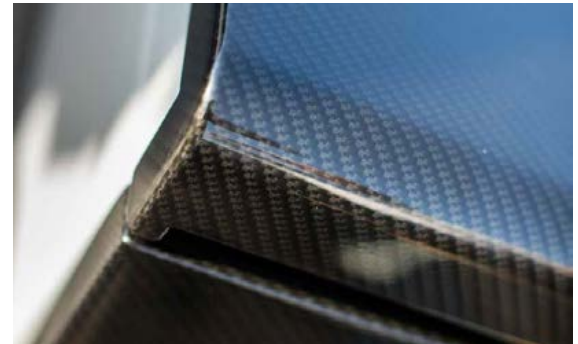












YACHTING AS IT SHOULD BE
