Summary

From June 2018, the Community Development team have been working with all residents, and specifically engaging with the Somali, Persian, and Arab communities across the estate.

In total, we have added **£1,592,040** value to the estate and wider North Kensington in terms of income, donations, grants and other benefits that have a clear financial value.

This comes from $\pounds 1,308.398$ in jobs, $\pounds 19,540$ in training, $\pounds 21,808$ in increased household income, $\pounds 29,902$ in expenditure via SMEs in North Kensington and $\pounds 167,767$ in grants and donations. We have also provided 9 apprenticeship opportunities to our growing in-house repairs teams.
