Summary

From June 2018, we have added **£1.9m** value to the estate and wider North Kensington in terms of income, donations, grants, and other benefits that have a clear financial value.

This comes from **£1.59m** in jobs, **£25k** in training, **£23k** in increased household income, **£57k** in expenditure via SMEs in North Kensington and **£188k** in grants and donations. We have also provided **11** paid work placements for residents, through our LancWest Works programme.
