We are writing on behalf of Nottingwood House Resident's Association support of The Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea (RBKC) Council proposal for the 2030 Future Neighbourhoods application in Notting Dale.

We therefore confirm that we would like to partner with the Council to support with engaging the community and delivering a series of initiatives and together as part of this application, such as the Nottingwood Nature Garden and Jasmine Wall, and explore undertaking work that will help to improve drainage to over 100 social homes, after 13 homes recently experienced the impacts of climate-related flash flooding in July 2021.

Nottingwood House Residents Association is an elected representative body of the residents of Nottingwood House in Notting Dale Ward.

We strongly support this application which will not only tackle environmental issues in a holistic way; but will embed green recovery at the heart and bring benefits for the community, particularly support the most disadvantaged residents and unrepresented groups in Notting Dale.

Through this letter, we acknowledge specific roles and responsibilities we will fulfil in this partnership such as liaising with the residents of our estate and providing them with updates of progress, supporting in obtaining feedback on the design and utilisation of new green spaces, and urban drainage programme exploration.

We are currently exploring match funding/have match funding to support with the delivery of these projects/initiatives through our Estate Improvement Budget and Grenfell Housing Legacy Fund.


