Camelford Court Roof Improvement Works – Voting results

We are delighted to share the results of the resident vote for the roof improvement works to your block. The new energy efficient roof chosen by residents is for maximum solar panels, with dedicate green roof areas which will be co-designed with residents.

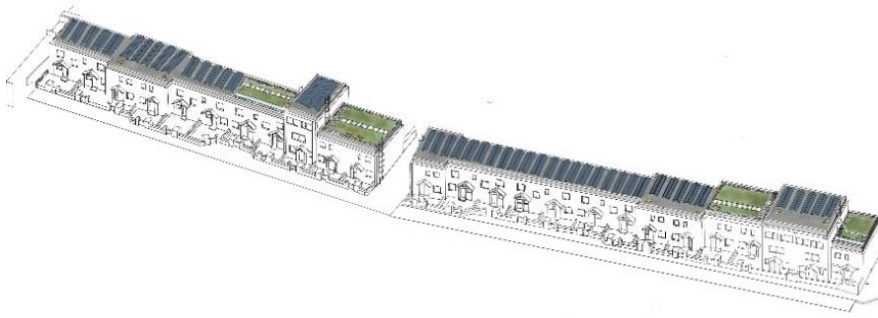
The architects Penoyre & Prasad presented their original design proposals to residents in March. The designs were then updated to incorporate resident feedback and in June, Camelford Court residents were asked to choose between three options:

Option 1: Maximum solar panels

Option 2: Solar panels only in the centre of the blocks, or

Option 3: An almost equal mix of solar panels and green roof.

The results are in!



We received **17 residents' responses (68%)** and after totalling the ballots: **Option 1** was found to be the preferred design with an overall 58% of votes. This means the new roof installation will include approximately **420m² of solar panels** and **190m² of green roof**.

This new energy efficient roof installation on an existing block will be the first of its kind on the estate and, we believe, in the borough, and will be another step towards our ambition of becoming a carbon neutral estate by 2030.

We will be in touch with you in the weeks ahead to explain the construction phase, let you know when works will start and address any questions and concerns you might have.
