The traineeship is open to those aged 16 to 25, who are studying and/or living in RBKC.



Day 1: Wednesday 23 August

- Introduction to hand tools used in woodwork and housebuilding

- Learn about elevations and plans
- Level foundations and start assembling the structure

Day 3: Friday 25 August

- Continue structure assembly outside
- Afternoon presentations from Goldfinger's Designer-Maker team

Day 4: Tuesday 29 August

- Off-site day trip to one of Goldinger
 Academy's partners, learning more about
 wood and its different uses

- Learn to cut mortice and tenon joint
- Add new sections to timber frame structure using hand-cut joinery

- Finish building timber frame structure
